## **General Guidelines**

- Campers are expected to be courteous to councilors and instructors at all times.
- Campers should be inspired through personal motivation to be a guide to others, have a positive attitude, and be honest to self and others.

## **Rules of the Camp**

- When on special excursions, campers are to stay with their group
